






























Between Point of Registration and 60 days prior to departure your deposit is non-refundable and non-transferrable. (Please refer to the deposit amount listed on your registration form.)


Between 45 and 60 days prior to departure 30% of the total trip cost is non-refundable and non-transferrable.

- The cost of a student/adult traveler is \$453.00
 - Travelers can either pay in full by October 26th or commit to the following payment plan:

 - Allows us to hold the airfare.
 - \$177 payment by December 2nd
 - Final payment of \$176 by January 2nd
 - * this is based on each traveler (adults and students)
- The first payment is collected online through EDT.

Frequently Asked Questions

- •Q: What is the cost?
 - \$ 453 (per student or parent)
 - \$ 253 person without flight (land only)
- •Q: Will there be fundraising for student of chaperone trips?
 - •There will be a fundraising event to support families who require financial assistance/transportation to airport. This decision will be made after parents provide insight into needs.

Medication Needs

- •Q: What do I do if my child will need to take medication during the trip?
 - •Each medication would require the district medication form: Parent/Guardian and Authorized Health Care Provider Request for Medication.
 - •Forms are available on the website or the office
 - •Contact Mrs. Laura Younger at ext. 75204 if you have any individual questions.
 - •Form must be completed by the doctor including all medications- even over the counter medications.
 - Medications cannot be expired and needs to be in it's original container
 - •Please have these items turned in one week before the trip to Mrs. Younger on Friday, February 18th
 - •Teacher or Mrs. Coltey will carry the medication. No Medication can be carried in students backpacks.

Frequently Asked Questions

- •Q: How do we sign up and when do we have to commit?
 - •Turn in the Intent to Participate form Friday, October 22nd. We need this form turned in from ALL STUDENTS- whether they are participating or not.
 - •Deadline for registration form is October 26th (Strict Deadline) to guarantee a spot on flight.

Registration is required online

- •Travelers will pay in full by October 26th or will commit to the payment plan.
- •Registration needs to be completed October 26th will be dependent on space availability.
- •Q: If I choose not to send my student what will be taking place at school?
